<u>DATES:</u>	Saturday, May 24, 2008 and Sunday, May 25, 2008
<u>LOCATION:</u>	Sonny Werblin Recreation Center Rutgers University 656 Bartholomew Road Piscataway, NJ 08854 732-445-0460 (for emergencies ONLY)
<u>FACILITY:</u>	The pool is Olympic-sized - 8 lane by 50 meters. The pool uses pedestal-style starting blocks, with non-turbulent lane lines, and a Colorado Timing system. There are two auxiliary pools, known as "patio pools" (for warm-up and warm-down), and seating for 1,000 spectators, including 400 chair-backed seats. The remaining seating is bleacher style. Access to the pool deck will be via the staircase nearest the diving tower end of the pool. Officials, timers and other meet workers, and swimmers exiting the Main Pool will only use stairs at the scoreboard end of the pool. Parking is available in various Rutgers lots. Please park only where "SWIM MEET PARKING" signs are posted and follow the instruction of the Rutgers Security Guards

<u>ENTRY DEADLINE:</u>	<p>Entries will be accepted no earlier than April 1 and must be <u>received no later than</u> Friday, May 2, 2008. The entry coordinator will accept entries as they are received and will stop accepting entries when the meet and/or session is full. Entry fees and hard copy must be received prior to start of swim meet.</p> <p>Berkeley Aquatic Club must adhere to NJ Swimming four hour per session limit.</p> <p>Entries will not be considered complete unless the waiver form is in accordance with the 2008 New Jersey Swimming rules, a non-refundable entry fee of \$5.00 per Senior Event, \$4.00 per Age Group and \$9.00 per relay event must accompany the entries.</p> <p>Make checks payable to "Blue Streak Aquatic."</p>
<u>MEET FORMAT WAIVER:</u>	The host club has the right to change the format of the meet with the approval of the sanctioning chairman and age group or senior chairman. These changes would be made for a more efficient swim meet for the swimmers and the host club. Reasons for these changes would be to allow more swimmers to swim; to conform to facility capacity limits or for facility safety concerns; to condense the meet into smaller time frame.

<p><u>INTERNET WEB POSTING:</u></p>	<p>Meet information and a Hy-Tek event list with time standards, importable into Team Manager, will be posted on the Berkeley Aquatic Website and on New Jersey Swimming website: www.berkeleyaquatic.org and www.njswim.org</p> <p>Psyche sheets will be posted on the website no later than the Tuesday before the swim meet. Session by session results will be posted at the end of each day and final results, in HTML and Word format will be posted by 5 p.m. the Monday following the meet. A Hy-tek file of results, including splits, will also be available on the website.</p> <p>Any changes to the meet format or schedule will be posted on the website.</p>
<p><u>MEET REQUIREMENT STATEMENT:</u></p>	<p>This meet qualifies, as "one" of the two required long course meets to be eligible for the New Jersey LC Zone Championship Team or for New Jersey National Championship Reimbursement.</p>
<p><u>COACHES:</u></p>	<p>All coaches "on the deck" must be members of USA Swimming with 2008 coaching credentials including background checks. Coaches must show coaching card with background check validation for entrance to facility. Coaches must show coaching card before picking up any meet information or scratch sheets. Coaches must have coaching card visible at all times while on deck, when entering hospitality area or when asking for food at concessions</p>
<p><u>OFFICIALS:</u></p>	<p>Participating clubs are requested to provide as many USA-S certified officials as possible. Please email Bruce Petersen at Bruce.Petersen@qs.com to volunteer. Please include the days and sessions you are able to work. Officials working any session of the meet must present their 2008 swimming official's credentials, as well as their 2008 USA Swimming membership card first to admissions when entering the building, and second to the Meet Referee on deck; otherwise, admission will be charged and the official will not be eligible to work the meet.</p>
<p><u>SWIMMER ELIGIBILITY:</u></p>	<p>Swimmers must be USA-S registered (or other FINA member) in order to enter and compete in this meet. All swimmers must be listed in the team's official entry file in order to participate in the meet, including relay only swimmers. Any transfer swimmer(s) must swim unattached for 120 days from their last competition. Please enter them as a separate team named XXXUN where XXX is the first three letters of your team abbreviation. Entries for swimmers without valid 2008 USA-S registrations will not be entered in the meet. NJ Swimming performs a registration check a few days after the official deadline and ineligible swimmers will be notified at that time.</p> <p>All swimmers must meet the attached time standards. Times converted from Short Course times are allowed.</p> <p>Swimmers entered in more than three (3) individual events in a preliminary or timed final session who fail to scratch down to this number before the check-in/scratch deadline established for the session will only be eligible to swim in the first three (3) events in the chronological, not event order, for which the swimmer was entered in that session.</p> <p>The thirty (30) minute scratch rule, and USA Swimming Scratch Procedures and penalties as contained in USA Swimming Rule 207.12.10 D and E will apply to all swimmers qualifying for bonus, consolations, and finals.</p> <p>Clubs will be fined \$50 per swimmer who fails to show for Sunday night Finals.</p> <p>Age group is determined by the swimmer's age on Saturday, May 24, 2008.</p>

<u>MEET FORMAT:</u>	<p>This meet will be run in accordance with 2008 USA Swimming Rules.</p> <p>All Age Group events will be swum as timed finals. Senior events, with the exception of the 800 and 1500, will be a trials and finals format, with bonus, consolation, and championship finals (fastest 24 swimmers from preliminaries) held in the evening session. The 1500 and 800 will be swum as timed finals with the fastest heat of each swum in the evening with Finals. Teams are limited to 2 relays per event. All relays are timed finals. The top 16 seeded relays will be swum at night. All other heats of relays will be run at the end of the preliminary session prior to the 800 and 1500 Freestyle heats.</p>																		
<u>CHECK-IN and SCRATCHES:</u>	<p>All check in sheets must be turned into the control room 30 minutes before the start of the session. Swimmers who are swimming will have lines through their names. Swimmers who are being scratched will have their names circled with "SCR" next to the circle. A swimmer scratching a single event will have a line through his or her name and the event number circled with "SCR" next to the circle.</p> <p>The thirty (30) minute scratch rule, and USA Swimming Scratch Procedures and penalties as contained in USA Swimming Rule 207.12.10 D and E will apply to all swimmers qualifying for bonus, consolations, and finals.</p> <p>New Jersey Swimming Policy identifies that clubs/swimmers will be fined \$50 per swimmer who fails to show for Sunday night Finals. In addition, swimmers failing to appear for Saturday night finals will be ineligible to swim Sunday.</p>

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<u>WARM UP PROCEDURES:</u>	<p>All teams will warm up at the same time. Lanes will not be assigned. Circle swimming will be in the counterclockwise direction. Entry shall be from the starting block end of each pool and must be feet first. At the Meet Referee's discretion, Lane 1 may be designated a pace lane and Lanes 6, 7 and 8 may be designated one way lanes. Relay starts may not be used. The warm-up will be conducted in accordance with New Jersey Swimming Warm up Policies. Uniformed and designated Safety Marshals will monitor warm-ups.</p>																		
<u>ENTRY TIMES:</u>	<p>All entry times must meet the attached qualification times. Please note that there are two separate qualification times for the distance events, one for members of the New Jersey LSC, and one for everyone else. Times may be converted from short course times but must be entered as meter times.</p>																		
<u>DISTANCE EVENT:</u>	<p>The Senior 800 and 1500 freestyles are timed final events and will be limited to the fastest 24 entries unless time permits additional heats to be swum. The fastest heat of each event will be swum in the finals session. The remaining heats will be swum fastest to slowest at the end of the preliminary sessions on Saturday and Sunday. Swimmers in the 800 & 1500 must provide their own counters. Berkeley Aquatic will provide timers.</p> <p>Swimmers who enter these two distance events must prove their qualifying time by listing date and name of meet on the entry form. There are two cut-off times for the 800 and 1500 freestyle. Non-New Jersey swimmers must meet or better the faster cut-off time.</p>																		

<u>HEAT LIMITED EVENTS:</u>	As noted above, the 800 and 1500 are limited to 24 swimmers, unless time permits additional heats. That decision will be made the day of the meet, after scratches. Psyche sheets will be posted on www.berkeleyaquatic.org . If the meet director suspects that the number of heats will be limited, she will contact all the clubs with swimmers entered in the distance events by email, not later than the Tuesday before the meet. In the event that Berkeley Aquatic Club limits the number of heats of the distance events and some swimmers who have previously entered are not allowed to swim, entry fees will be refunded at the control room after the distance event is seeded and heat sheets posted.						
<u>RELAYS:</u>	All relays must have the correct four names listed on the relay card in the correct order for that relay to be eligible. Coaches must turn in relay cards no later than 30 minutes prior to the event. All swimmers must be listed in the team's official entry file in order to participate in the meet, including relay only swimmers . The order of the swimmers and the names may be changed by notifying the timer in the relay lane or the computer desk but must be done prior to the start of the heat. No changes will be made after the relay is swum.						
<u>SCORING:</u>	Scoring for the team title will be through 16 places for Senior events as follows: (20,17,16,15,14,13,12,11,9,7,6,5,4,3,2,1) for individual events and for relay events (40,34,32,30,28,26,24,22,18,14,12,10,8,6,4,2). Scoring for the team title will be through 8 places for Age Group Individual events as follows: (9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1).						
<u>AWARDS:</u>	Memorial Day Invitational medals will be presented to the top 3 finishers in individual and relay events. Trophies will be presented to the three teams accumulating the highest scores.

<u>ADMISSION AND PROGRAMS:</u>	<p>Admission will be \$6.00 per morning or afternoon session.</p> <p>Programs will be \$10.00 for psyche sheets for the entire meet. If time permits, all holders of programs will be given heat sheets for the session AFTER the start of the session at no additional charge.</p> <p>Finals admission will be \$3.00 and will include a heat sheet program</p>						
<u>ENTRIES:</u>	<p>In accordance with NJS policy, entries may be submitted by email to rkingjr@comcast.net. All entries must be Hy-Tek program entries as an attached file to an email. The meet entry coordinator will respond to emails within 48 hours. If you do not receive an email response within 48 hours, assume that your email has not been received. It is the e-mailer's responsibility to make sure that the entry coordinator receives the email. If you do not receive an email response, you must contact the entry coordinator by email or phone or mail in your entries. An Entry Summary with a signed NJ Swimming waiver and a check must accompany or follow each entry. Entries must be submitted in meters times only but may be converted from yards. No phone or faxed entries will be accepted. If you are not emailing your entries, overnight or express mail is recommended, but waive the signature. It is not necessary to overnight or express mail checks and waivers which are sent in support of an emailed entry.</p> <p>Note: Fed-Ex, Airborne and other carriers cannot deliver to P.O. Boxes. If you mail your entries directly to our facility and not to our P.O. Box, we may not receive it in a timely manner and are not responsible for receiving it. Please send mail only to our P.O. Box.</p> <p>Entry Fees must be paid before start of meet. Please make all checks payable to Blue Steak Aquatic.</p>

<u>HOST CLUB RESPONSIBILITIES:</u>	A hospitality room will be maintained for coaches and officials. It is located behind the control room on the pool deck. Berkeley Aquatic Club will provide all timers, including timers for distance events.
<u>PARTICIPATING CLUB RESPONSIBILITIES:</u>	Participating clubs are encouraged to provide as many officials as possible. Contact Bruce Petersen at Bruce.Petersen@gs.com . Clubs do not need to provide timers. Swimmers in the distance events must provide their own counters. Participating club parents must stay off the pool deck. <u>No pets are allowed!</u>
<u>CONCESSIONS:</u>	Rutgers University will provide a varied menu of hot and cold refreshments throughout the competition.
<u>VENDOR:</u>	The Metro Swim Shop will be located at the opposite end of the Concourse from the spectator entrance.

Turn off at Exit 129 for the New Jersey Turnpike and head south. Turn off at Exit 9, bear right after the tollbooths and follow signs for "Route 18 North – New Brunswick." Stay to the left to continue on Route 18 North. Proceed along Route 18 North, crossing the Raritan River (approximately 3.7 miles). Continue on Route 18 North. Proceed up Route 18 to the Campus Rd. exit ramp on the right. Follow Campus Rd. until you come to the circle and take the first right off the circle onto Bartholomew Rd. Garden State Parkway Northbound

False Registration: An LSC may impose a fine of up to **\$100 per event** against a member coach or a member club's representative signing a document which indicates a swimmer is registered with United States Swimming for a meet when that swimmer is not properly registered or eligible to compete for that club. This will be enforced by the LSC and the LSC will be entitled to the fines imposed.
